Parent's Code of Conduct

- a) I will not force my child to participate in hockey.
- b) I will remember that my child plays hockey for his or her enjoyment, not mine.
- c) I will put my child's health and wellbeing ahead of the game. I will not have my child play injured or sick.
- d) I will encourage my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflict without resorting to hostility or violence.
- e) I will teach my child that doing one's best is as important as winning so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of the game.
- f) I will make my child feel like a winner every time by offering praise for competing fairly and hard.
- g) I will never ridicule or yell at any child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- h) I will remember that Children learn by example. I will applaud good plays and performances by both my child's team and their opponents.
- i) I will never question the official's judgment or honesty in public. I recognize officials are being developed in the same manner as the players.
- j) I will support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from children's hockey games.
- k) I will recognize the value and importance of volunteer coaches and manager. I will comply with reasonable requests of team management e.g., arrival times prior to practices and games.
- I) I will not criticize the coach and manager in front of my child. I will discuss my concerns directly with the coach or manager to ascertain their objectives and ideas.
- m) I will not use racial slur, bully, harass or abuse whether physical, emotional, or sexual towards anyone.
- n) I will conduct the objectives and policies of the Eastern Ontario Wild AAA Hockey Association, which are consistent with the objectives and policies of my home association.
- o) I will follow and adhere to all Eastern Ontario Wild Policies, including the Wild social media Policy.
- p) I will strive to know and adhere to all ideals, policies and rules of the HEO, HEO Minor and Hockey Canada.
